## Special Strike Announcement - Wednesday 1st March 2023

You may be aware from media coverage that the NEU teaching union have declared strike action, which will take place in the first instance on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2023. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay and conditions, and not because of any issues at our school.

At present school will be closed to all pupils in Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6.

Children in Nursery, Reception classes, Time for Twos and pupils in TLC will be expected to attend as normal.
